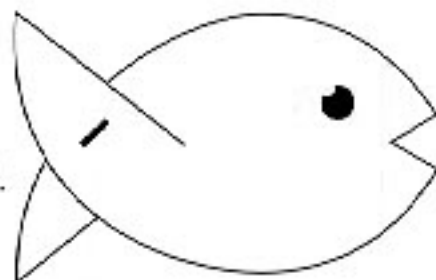


A Fish on a Line

Make: A Fish on a Line

Card, scissors, stapler, crayons, cotton, straws.

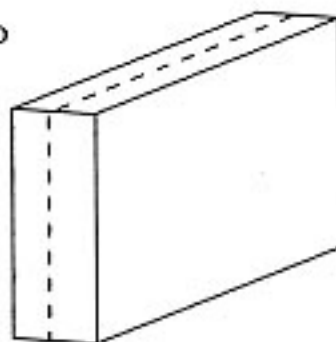
1. Copy and cut out the fish opposite using card.
2. Colour on both sides with crayon.
3. Cut along the line in the middle.
4. Cross over the two sides of the cut and staple to make a tail.
5. Thread a length of cotton from the top of the fish's back and tie on to a drinking straw to look like a fish on a line.



Rhyme: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5,
Once I caught a fish alive.
6, 7, 8, 9, 10,
Then I let it go again.
Why did you let it go?
Because it bit my finger so.
Which finger did it bite?
This little finger on my right.

(Traditional)

Activity: Make an aquarium using a cereal box cut into two. Colour the inside blue or line with blue tissue paper covered with glue. Put glue on to base and cover with sand. Make some fishes out of card and suspend from the top. Add seaweed, pebbles, etc.



Talk About: The parts of a fish e.g. scales, gills, tail, eyes.
Look at live fish in a fish tank or aquarium, a fish from a fish mongers etc.
Touch the scales.
