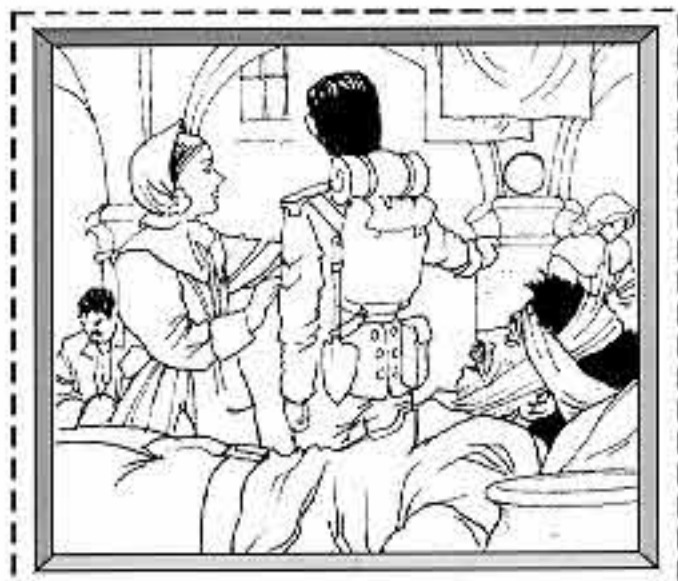


Florence Nightingale's Story in Pictures
